Daily Schedule

- School day starts at 7:50 a.m. and ends at 2:27 p.m. The first bell rings at 7:40 a.m. They are held in the lobby until that time.
- There are 9 class periods in a day. Periods are 41 minutes long with the exception of period 2 which is 45 minutes to allow for announcements etc. **STUDENTS ARE ALLOWED 3 MINUTES BETWEEN CLASSES.**
- Teachers are here until 3:00 pm everyday and students are encouraged to stay after for additional support from 2:27-3:00.

Procedures

No more handing in notes to your teacher for everything:

- If they need to **leave early** from school the note needs to be provided to the main office before or during homeroom. They must sign out.
- If they are **late** to school you must provide a note to the main office, and sign in.
- If you are **absent** from school you must hand in a note to your homeroom teacher. **YOU MUST BE OUT 2 consecutive DAYS FOR A HOMEWORK REQUEST TO BE MADE.** You must contact the secretary in the counseling office for a homework request.
- If they need to make a phone call at school there is a phone for student use in the counseling office.
- Cell phone use during school hours are determined by zones within the building Red= No Use, Yellow=Staff Discretion, Green= Can Use

Passes

- When they leave a classroom, they are required to have a pass.
- Passes are located in the back of their planner. First planner is free, if it gets lost there is a \$5.00 fee to purchase a new one.
- Reasons for passes: So all students are accounted for at all times. Passes are used for the following: Restroom, Library, Computer Lab, Nurse, or Offices etc. Any where you may need to go in between the bells. Passes must be signed by a staff member.

Personal Belongings

- Each student is assigned a locker.
- It is unique to them and they are the only one with the combination. It is encouraged that students do their best to use these to keep their belongings safe and have less to carry around all day.
- 3 minutes is a very long time to get to class. Lockers are located in the same hallway as their classes so there is plenty of time.
- **Morning: get books needed for classes before lunch**
- **Afternoon: get books needed for classes after lunch**
- **End of Day: get books needed for homework**

Behavior

- As a 7th grade student there are certain behaviors that are expected of them.
- There is much more freedom within their school day, thus it is of the utmost importance that they adhere to the expectations in all areas of the building.
- Move quickly and efficiently to your classes. Not a time for horseplay and socializing.
- Be quiet at the start of 2nd period so everyone can hear the important information shared on announcements.
- The cafeteria is a large group of students in a large area. Therefore it is important that they eat and use manners appropriately.

Classroom Expectations

- Must come ready to learn with all materials needed.
- They no longer have their own desk with all their materials on hand.
- It is their responsibility to have them when they arrive to class.
- Write down all homework assignments in their planner whether it is done or not. They are always posted in the classroom.
