Dear General Brown Community,

I am happy to report that as of today, Jefferson County's 14-Day Rolling Average of COVID 19 Percentage Positive Results is down to 5.2%. In addition, we have witnessed a steep decline in the number of positive cases, isolations, and quarantines among students and employees since transitioning to remote instruction for all students in January. As a result, the General Brown Central School District will resume in-person instruction using the hybrid model of learning on Monday, February 22, 2021.

This is a reminder that all students and employees are expected to complete a screening tool on the COVID-19 Screening Website at <https://entry.neric.org/gbliions> each day prior to entering any school building. All students and staff should be symptom-free and under no isolation or quarantine notice from Jefferson County Public Health or New York State Department of Health. In addition, any students and employees that traveled to any state other than those that are contiguous with New York State (Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Vermont) are required to comply with the New York State COVID-19 Travel Advisory and provide proof of two negative COVID-19 tests or the mandatory 10-day quarantine as required by the Travel Advisory. Evidence of such should be provided to the building's school nurse prior to entering the school building.

I want to thank you for your ongoing commitment to the General Brown Central School District. We recognize that remote instruction caused disruptions to families' daily schedules, but our top priority has always been the health and safety of our students and employees. We look forward to the students' return, and we will keep you apprised of any updates related to the pandemic.
