Dear Parents & Guardians:

The General Brown Central School District continues to make safety our top priority. As reported previously, Leadership meets regularly, discussing and monitoring our daily procedures, as well as planning for a continued emphasis on the safety of all students, staff, and visitors in the General Brown school buildings. Beginning this fall, as you entered one of the school buildings during the school day, you probably experienced first-hand some of the new safety equipment we have installed, such as locked doors with video cameras for visitors' admittance controlled by office staff at limited entrances, as well as lockdown audio and visual alerts in each building.

We are happy to announce that we have just added one more feature, Visitu, a visitor registration management system that allows us to monitor visitors within each building, print identification badges, run offender checks, and generate notifications to Leadership for safety alerts. Effective immediately, we ask that all parents and guardians that plan to enter any school building beyond the Main Office, please bring your government-issued identification (i.e. NYS Driver's License) for each visit, so that you can be registered in our school database. You will be asked to sign-in using an iPad, and your identification will be scanned into the system. Once cleared, a visitor's badge will be generated, and we ask that you wear the badge throughout your visit in the school building. This may, initially, seem like an inconvenience, but other districts are finding this system effective in monitoring visitors within their school buildings. We appreciate your cooperation and consideration in this extra measure we have taken to ensure the safety of the children during the school day. While we recognize that no one thing will guarantee our safety, we are confident that our safety measures will reduce some level of vulnerability.


